Session Update

HB 147

Georgia Technology Authority; annual inventory of artificial intelligence usage by state agencies; provide - 01/30/2025 - Technology and Infrastructure Innovation

The bill successfully passed the House with a unanimous vote of 172-0 on February 20, 2025. Subsequently, it was read and referred to the Senate on February 21, 2025. On March 10, 2025, the bill was withdrawn and recommitted in the Senate, indicating further deliberations are ongoing.

Session Update

HB 171

Crimes and offenses; obscenity; repeal and replace Code Section 16-12-80 - 02/03/2025 - Judiciary Non-Civil

The bill successfully passed the House with a unanimous vote of 160-0 on February 26, 2025. It was then read and referred to the Senate on February 27, 2025, where it is currently under consideration by the Senate Judiciary Committee.

Session Update

SB 9

Ensuring Accountability for Illegal AI Activities Act; Judiciary
01/15/2025

The bill was introduced in the Senate on January 14, 2025, and passed with a vote of 46-9 on March 4, 2025. It was subsequently referred to the House, where it was withdrawn and recommitted on March 11, 2025, indicating that further deliberations are ongoing.
